

LIMITED WARRANTY ON DC AIR PRODUCTS

1. General. This Limited Warranty ("Limited Warranty") of Freedom Technologies Group LLC ("FTG") gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state. This Limited Warranty can also be found online at www.ftgimaging.com/support or in the documentation provided by FTG with the DC-Air™ sensor, the docking station and the holders (the "Products") purchased by you.

2. Limited Warranty. FTG warrants that during the twenty-four (24) month period from the date of purchase of the Products (the "Limited Warranty Period"), the Products will be free from defects and that the Products will function substantially in accordance with the specifications or the instructions for use. FTG's responsibility for defective Products is limited to repair, replacement, or refund.

EXCEPT FOR THE WARRANTY SET FORTH ABOVE, FTG MAKES NO WARRANTY WHATSOEVER WITH RESPECT TO THE PRODUCTS, INCLUDING ANY (A) WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY; (B) WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE; OR (D) WARRANTY AGAINST INFRINGEMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS OF A THIRD PARTY; WHETHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED BY LAW, COURSE OF DEALING, COURSE OF PERFORMANCE, USAGE OF TRADE, OR OTHERWISE.

3. Exclusions from the Limited Warranty. The Limited Warranty does not cover any defects or damage relating or attributable to (a) normal wear and tear; (b) defects and errors attributable to external factors, such as electricity fluctuations, accidents or exposure to vibrations, heat or cold beyond the specified range or other elements, mechanical shocks, including dropping the sensor or the docking station, severe bite marks, marks and scratches created by sharp objects; (c) modifications to the Products; (d) unauthorized repair; (e) misuse of the Products, i.e., using the Products outside the scope detailed in the operator's manual or against the instructions for use; (f) tapering or removing the battery cover and/or the battery and/or attempting to replace the rechargeable battery; (g) cleaning and disinfecting the Products in a manner or with disinfectants that is not compliant to the "Cleaning and Disinfection" instructions provided in the operator's manual; or

(h) failure to comply with the environmental and radiation specifications.

4. Complaints. Complaints of defects or damage to the Products must be made in writing to FTG within thirty (30) days of discovery of the defect or damage. The written complaint must describe in sufficient detail the defect or damage so that FTG can determine whether the defect or damage is covered by this Limited Warranty. If FTG reasonably requests, you must demonstrate how and when the defect occurs. If it is determined that the defect or damage is covered by this Limited Warranty, FTG shall remedy the defective or damages Product in accordance with Section 1 of this Limited Warranty.

5. Sole Remedy. This Limited Warranty shall constitute FTG's sole obligation, and your sole remedy in case of any error, defect, fault or non-conformance in the Products. After the expiration of the Warranty Period, FTG's liability for any defects or errors shall be limited to what has been agreed to by the Parties in a separate support arrangement, if any.

6. Optional Extended Warranty. You may, at your option and expense, purchase an extended warranty to cover loss and damage to the Products associated with defects and errors attributable to accidents involving the Products.

7. Assignment. This Limited Warranty extends only to you and does not extend to any subsequent owner or other transferee of the Products.

8. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution. The validity, interpretation, construction and performance of this Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the state of Indiana without regard to the conflicts of laws principles thereof. Any disputes regarding this Agreement which cannot be settled amicably will be submitted to arbitration in Indianapolis, Indiana in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association ("AAA"). The arbitration proceeding shall be held before one arbitrator selected in accordance with AAA rules.

9. Severability. If for any reason any provision of this Limited Warranty is found to be unenforceable, such provision and the remainder of this Limited Warranty shall be enforced to the extent possible.
